Footnotes

SILIC (FR) allowed to settle, advanced into contention four wide on the far turn, caught LEND A HAND just inside the eighth pole and was put to pressure to last. TUZLA (FR) was taken in hand for six furlongs, swung to the outside for the stretch run and closed fast to just miss. DOCKSIDER in hand early, advanced into contention around the far turn, angled out for the stretch run and finished willingly between horses. LEND A HAND (GB) chased the pace three wide, took over command at the top of the stretch, fought back when headed by SILIC, then gave way grudgingly late. HAWKSLEY HILL (IRE) settled well off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and finished willingly. BRAVE ACT (GB) prompted the pace into the far turn, gained a brief lead approaching the stretch and weakened. DELAY OF GAME showed early foot along the inside, then was checked in traffic leaving the far turn and tired. KIRKWALL (GB) saved ground, slipped through to reach contention in early stretch but had no late response while racing in traffic. JIM AND TONIC (FR) steadied in behind the leader on the first turn, remained in contention along the hedge into the far turn, checked approaching the stretch and faltered. MIDDLESEX DRIVE

steadied along the hedge around the first turn, lacked racing room in the stretch and failed to threaten. KHUMBA MELA (IRE) raced in striking position into the far turn and came up empty. SUSU (GB) broke poorly and failed to reach contention. GARBU showed speed four wide into the first turn, angled to hedge to make the pace into the far turn and gave way. QUIET RESOLVE chased the leaders into the backstretch and stopped.
