Footnotes

SWEET LUCA was settled between foes in the last flight in the opening quarter, gathered momentum while shifting out racing through the turn, angled four wide in upper stretch while steadily drawing into striking distance and continued with a solid late response to prevail in time under firm left handed encouragement. FEELS LIKE FLYING, prompted to secure a position tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance off the inside racing to the turn, continued with a steady, three wide advance racing into upper stretch to bid for command between foes leaving the furlong marker and was just outkicked. TWELVE HUNDRED, urged soon after the break to gain terms with the leaders racing three deep to the bend, moved to wrest command nearing upper stretch, opened a clear advantage in the fifth furlong but failed to sustain his momentum. DANDYMAN, unhurried in early stages while angling to the inside, saved ground to upper stretch and gained some position while making no real impression on the leaders. PRICELESS SHORE, off a step slowly, was settled outside foes in the last flight racing to the turn and never seriously menaced. ROCKET PROFESSOR, urged to secure a forward placing just off the pacesetter in the opening stages, was spent after three furlongs. STARK RAVIN MAD sprinted to the lead along the inside from the break, set the pace into the turn and gave way abruptly once headed nearing upper stretch.
