Breeders' Cup monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup monies not awarded will revert to the Fund. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner and trainer. Breeders' Cup Limited shall also present a trophy to the winning owner.

Footnotes

ZENYATTA broke a bit slowly then was bumped between horses and squeezed back, settled off the rail, moved up three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, took a short lead in midstretch and drew clear under a steady hand ride. SANTA TERESITA stalked outside a rival then three deep, bid outside the pacesetter leaving the second turn, gained the advantage between foes nearing the stretch, fought back inside the winner while drifting in some in the stretch, was no match for that one late but clearly second best. KRIS' SIS came out a bit and was bumped at the break, saved ground chasing the pace, angled out into the stretch and bested the others. ROMANCE IS DIANE bumped between horses at the start, took the early lead and angled in, set the pace under a rating hold along the rail, resisted briefly when challenged leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. DOUBLE TROUBLE (BRZ) also bumped at the start, stalked just off the rail then between horses, fell back some midway on the second turn, angled in leaving that turn and also weakened.
