WELL FASHIONED raced in hand early off the pace, responded well when asked for a run up the hill, gained through the lane and was up in time. KISSER N RUN raced along the inside after taking a rating position, advanced to take the lead entering the stretch and was caught at the wire. EURO POWER raced towards the rear to the backstretch and improved position in the late going. QUIET FLAINE set the pace for a mile and half, surrendered lead entering the final turn, was within striking position when swerving inward to avoid a fallen foe at the last fence and had nothing further. FLYING FRISKIE was outrun and distanced. THE GREY EXPRESS (GB) was never prominent, tired on the final turn and was pulled up. CUBIST was reserved from the outset, closed the gap with a late charge but fell at the last fence. MAYA CHARLI showed early speed, tired after the opening mile and pulled up at the twelfth fence.
