Footnotes

HERECOMESTHEMANNOW pressed pace from outset on the outside of rivals, responded to gain narrow edge mid stretch, kept to steady urging wire while draw clear. STEAL YOUR FACE allowed to settle in stride early, swung five wide into stretch, finished with a solid belated mid track rally to gain second spot. OKIE TIME trailed at the half along rail, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, lacked late kick in drive to wire. FIFTH DATE bobbled, broke in impeding rival at the break, righted and moved to front, went gamely to mid stretch, weakened. LAIDBACKLYUNNY stalked leaders for half, lacked needed response in drive. NO ADVANCE was never a serious threat.
