FASHION PLATE sped to the early lead inside, came a bit off the rail on the first turn and set the pace just off the fence, drifted inward in the late stages but held gamely under urging. RIA ANTONIA stalked inside then off the rail, went outside a rival leaving the backstretch and three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, loomed boldly behind the winner in midstretch but could not catch that one while clearly second best. BAJAN chased outside then off the rail, went alongside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, came out into the stretch and gained the show. HONEY RIDE stalked the pace a bit off the rail then outside a rival, angled to the inside leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. ARETHUSA angled in and saved ground off the pace, went outside a rival on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ARTEMIS bobbled some at the start, was between horses early, stalked a bit off the rail then inside and weakened in the stretch. SMOOOVE IT three deep early, angled in and chased inside, dropped back on the second turn and into the stretch and was eased in the drive but walked off.
