Late nominations close Thursday, February 15, 2001, by payment of \$2,500 each. Footnotes

POINT GIVEN had speed inside early, took back into the first turn and stalked a bit off the rail, bid outside the runner-up and dueled on the backstretch, took command under a hold a half mile out, inched away into the second turn and drew clear in the stretch with a tap of the stick and a steady hand ride while being shown the whip right handed. CRAFTY C. T. sped to a short early lead outside the winner, angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, fought back when challenged, was no match for POINT GIVEN but was clearly second best. I LOVE SILVER settled inside, came off the rail leaving the first turn, chased outside a rival on the backstretch, split horses nearing the quarter pole, came out for the stretch and bested the others. PALMEIRO outside a rival early, angled in approaching the first turn, then saved ground thereafter to no avail. CHEROKEE KIM angled in and was allowed to lag back along the inside to the stretch, came out and passed a tiring rival. SCORPION stalked outside a rival early, moved up outside the winner on the backstretch, continued outside the runner-up under urging on the second turn, went three deep leaving that turn and into the stretch, then weakened.
