AVEENU MALCAINU away without apparent mishap, took up the chase from the three path, got switched over to a drive a couple of jumps prior to spinning into the stretch, shifted slighter wider and then issued a stern bid upon reaching the furlong grounds, put away WHAT A CATCH after an abbreviated skirmish then shook free, kept to the task at hand. INALIENABLE RIGHTS scraped the left side of the starting gate after lunging with his initial step, raced from well off the inside throughout, travelled four wide on the turn, made it off the turn and was asked for more, steadily moved out into path seven down the stretch, gaining ground nevertheless, wore down WHAT A CATCH with three jumps to spare before the finish line to be along for the place. WHAT A CATCH prompted the pacesetter to that opponent's outside, going about in the three path after the nemesis got out two wide during the early stages of the run around the bend, was narrowly in front when put to encouragement in the general area of the three-sixteenths pole, got out-duelled by the winner soon afterwards, then lost the fight for the place in deep stretch to INALIENABLE RIGHTS. ANALYZE THE ODDS took the inside route, had the rider go to work past the five-sixteenths marker, was maneuvered out into path five from upper to midstretch, rallied mildly without posing a threat. MR. PETE rode the rail, was under some urging making his way on the turn, angled three wide at the three-sixteenths pole and came up empty. MORNING BREEZ was sharply angled over towards the inside down the backstretch, was proceeding along the inside approaching the half mile pole, got out into the two path almost immediately after stepping onto the top of the turn, kept from going much wider only due to the herculean grip being applied by the pilot on the left side, spun into the stretch still engaged with WHAT A CATCH, went back to a truer course after some solid right handed stick work at the head of the stretch, yielded for good but remained prominently placed for a little while longer then gave way. ALIEN INVASION two wide entering the turn, got fanned six wide exiting it, had no rally. SMOKIN PLATINUM had the rider take hold after lunging inward with his first step, reached out in a green manner racing on the backstretch, departed the half mile pole in the three path and failed to reach a contending position.
