Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs.; of a Sweepstake at a mile or over allowed 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance in 2019 allowed 6 lbs.; of such a race in 2018-19 allowed 8 lbs. CODE OF HONOR away last, was content to bring up the back of the pack for the opening three-quarters, stalked the pace four to five wide, as the widest of all on the turn, flashed interest as the third fraction was being finalized, angled into the path four for clearance at the top of the lane and was given his cue, surged to the lead to begin the final in front, but only barely, had already edged away when the pilot lost the whip a sixteenth later, then furthered extended the winning margin, set down to a hand drive the rest of the way to the wire. FINAL JEOPARDY took up the chase from the three path on the turn, increased his presence as six furlongs was being completed, was a few strides into the stretch run before getting called upon for more, got beaten to the front end by the winner, ventured onward with good energy procuring the place. ROWAYTON moved over to the inside route after the field had been sent off and running, narrowed in late on the bend, was eased towards the two path stepping into the lane, briefly drafting behind MAJID after having done so, saw no opportunity to tip farther to the outside, got steadied instead, altering course back over to the rail, was coming up the heels of another when altering course yet again, this time towards the path three, stayed on well to secure the show. MIHOS at or near the inside making his way on the backstretch, got roused being maneuvered into the four path early on the turn, commenced the stretch by tipping slightly wider, lacked the necessary response. MAJID grabbed the advantage shortly after the start, cut over to the rail, carved out the pace, spaced at a slight distance from off the inside route, came under heavy pressure approaching the quarter pole, shifted onto the two path when put to a drive for the drive home, got collared soon afterwards then steadily backed away. WHISKEY ECHO attained a forward position early on the backstretch, stalked the pace towards path two, spun into the lane under a ride from between rivals, fell back when pinched in upper stretch, unable to keep pace with several of the others, failed to regain any interest and was allowed to fade away.
