Footnotes

SPANISH POINT at a considerable distance from off the rail throughout, departed the backstretch from path four, was well in hand advancing towards the front runners, joining up with them by three-eighths pole, spun into the lane on near even terms with STUNNING MUNNINGS, settled in and was switched over to stronger handling, out-dueled the previously-mentioned foe to emerge at the eighth pole in charge, steadily extended the margin, kept to some encouragement to the end. STUNNING MUNNINGS got engaged with OUR LADY OF LORETO shortly after the start, moved over to the rail, showed the way hounded on the turn, intially facing pressure from two others to her outside and then from three once the winner arrived on the scene midpoint on the turn, came into the lane on dead even terms with that opponent, was let loose as a duel between them commenced, wound up the vanquished one, gave out at the sixteenth pole almost costing her the second place check. KEMBA kept watch on the disputed pace from path two in midpack, angled four wide for the drive home, rallied down the middle of the strip, fell shy of snatching away the place from a tiring STUNNING MUNNINGS. OUR LADY OF LORETO sparred for the top from path two, forced to do so from between foes on the turn, stepped into the lane and got shaken off, appeared to be moving evenly closing the gap late on STUNNING MUNNINGS as she backed away. LITTLE FARINA pressed the issue from the path three on the bend, between rivals for a portion of it, gave way after spinning into the stretch. SPEED TALKS took up position in midpack, shifted over closer to the rail approaching the half mile pole, was pulling on the bit until the five-sixteenths pole, ceased doing so after getting set down at that staion, fanned out five wide during the initial portion of the stretch, becoming the widest of all, failed to fire appreciably. CHEROKEE SONG remained in the two path after the start, got steadied as SPEED TALKS was moving sharply nearer the rail a short distance from the half mile pole, raced towards the rear during the run around the bend, was under some urging swinging into the lane, flashed some headway in the late stages,. LOOKN FINE AS WINE lost her footing springing from the gate, went on to save ground to no avail.
