SEEKING THE ANTE was outrun early, rallied four wide on the turn, reached the front nearing the eighth pole and was going away late under a drive. TRAVELATOR raced with the pace while three wide, rallied turning for home but was no match for the winner while clearly best of the others. STAR CELEBRITY was hustled along outside, raced three wide and had no response when roused. MAGNOLIA JACKSON was hustled from the gate, chased the pace while between rivals and lacked a rally. IHAVEADATE contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. CARLOW was outrun early, raced inside and offered a mild rally inside. SLEW MOTION was hustled up inside, contested the pace and tired in the final furlong. FLEET INDIAN raced close up early and had no response when roused. NEVAEH raced inside and tired in the stretch. GRAB BAG chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. LAPIS tired after a wide trip. PELHAM BAY raced inside and tired.
