FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. Free to nominate, \$250 to pass the entry box and \$250 additional to start, with \$35,000 guaranteed, of which \$21,000 guaranteed to the owner of the winner. All other purse monies paid corresponding with purse schedule in Condition Book. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$18,000 at a mile or over in 2011 allowed 2 lbs; \$15,000 at a mile or over in 2011, 4 lbs; \$10,000 at a mile or over in 2010-2011, 6 lbs; maidens, 8 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered in allowances). HIGH WEIGHTS PREFERRED. (Winners Preferred). Total earnings will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Thursday, June 9 with 20. (If management deems it inadvisable to run this race on the Turf, it will be run at a distance of 1 Mile on the main track.) (Rail at 10 feet).

TOURMALINE mid pack and inside, angled out and moved up into the second turn, gained a short lead through the second turn, then drew off in the lane under mild urging. PARIS BY NIGHT stalked the early pace outside, gained a short lead into the second turn while angling in, could not go with the winner into the stretch, stayed on to be best of the rest. ARTEMUS KITTEN well back and outside, looped rivals four wide through the second turn, bid on that path into the stretch and had a mild gain in the lane. CAROUSING mid pack and on the rail, gained a striking position through the second turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch and weakened in the drive. CONGRATS AND ROSES well placed and outside, looped rivals three wide through the second turn, bid on that path into the stretch and faded. LADY BERYL was never involved. CHEROKEE WOMAN set the early pace on a clear lead while pulling, then was through after a half.
