ASHKAL WAY (IRE) angled in on the first turn, moved out along the backstretch, swung five wide nearing the quarter pole, made a run to challenge in midstretch and prevailed in the late stages. CLASSIC CAMPAIGN stalked three wide for six furlongs, lodged a bid in upper stretch, battled into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. ELECTRIC LIGHT checked after breaking awkwardly, pressed the early pace, lodged a bid to challenge at the quarter pole, battled into midstretch and weakened late. GIANT WRECKER raced in hand along the rail while setting the pace into upper stretch and weakened. CHEIRON was outrun along the rail, drifted out in upper stretch and lacked a late response.
