BURNIN' MEMORIES was inside and saving ground on the turns, rallied two wide in the stretch and was in an all out drive to be along in time to prevail. EAGLE LAKE was well handled from the start while in hand, set easy fractions then was roused in mid stretch but was outfinished in the end. PROM DATE was allowed to settled then rallied three wide in the stretch to finish well but was no threat to the top two. MARFA'S TAXES was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn, angled out four wide in the stretch but was no threat. BIG MAG was unhurried early and was no threat. LITTLE SHON chased the pace while racing two wide, made a bid on the turn then faltered in the stretch. JADE AIR was no factor. CIENS STORM on the inside and saving ground on the turns, made a bid then stopped in the stretch.
