GAME WINNER tugged along the inside then was guided off the rail into the backstretch, stalked between horses then bid three wide between rivals a half mile out, continued three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, took a short lead in midstretch, battled outside the runner-up and drifted in some in the drive under a left handed crack of the whip inside the eighth pole, then pulled clear under steady handling and a hold late. PARSIMONY broke out a bit and bobbed slightly at the start, stalked outside the winner then off the rail, bid between horses leaving the backstretch, took a short advantage between foes on the second turn, battled inside the winner in the stretch, drifted in some and was clearly second best. KINGLY tugged his way to the front and angled in, set the pace inside then dueled leaving the backstretch, fought back on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong but held third. FEELING STRONG stalked a bit off the rail then came out into the backstretch, bid four wide a half mile out, dropped back and angled in some on the second turn and also weakened but was edged for the show. MINUS WIN POOL \$20,344.90.
