BEAU'S SURPRISE stalked the early pace from the two path, contended on the backstretch, then drew clear on the far turn and finished under strong urging. PANTHER POND was never far back, saved ground through the far turn, then angled out three wide at the 1/4 pole, made a bid but was no match for the winner. BRIMSTONE TOUGH set the pace from the start, raced along the inside, was headed on the backstretch and weakened at the top of the stretch. IMPRINTS IN GOLD was close up early, raced four wide throughout, then lacked a late response. FLASHY COUNT pressed the pace from the three path through the second turn, then faded in the stretch. J. D.'S HOLDIN' ON was along the two path on the backstretch and through early then was outrun.
