REAL QUIET moved up to contention entering the first turn, tracked the leaders in hand three wide, moved closer under urging nearing the quarter pole, drew even with FREE HOUSE in mid stretch, dueled with that rival to the wire and narrowly proved best under constant left handed encouragement. FREE HOUSE prompted the pace in hand while two wide, gained a short lead mid way on the final turn, was collared by REAL QUIET in mid stretch, dueled under left handed pressure and just failed. FRED BEAR CLAW jumped a pile of manure passing the sixteenth pole for the first time, set the pace along the inside, was headed mid way on the final turn then gave way grudgingly. PRECOCITY, far back early, lacked a serious stretch response. BRUSHING UP never menaced.
