Footnotes

SILVER AXE settled at the back of the field on the first turn while racing three wide, moved closer while remaining three deep on the final turn, rallied to the front fifty yards out and quickly drew clear under urging. AZUCAR (PER) pressed the pace from the two path to the final sixteenth and went willingly to the wire to gain the place. TRICKY MOCHA set the slow pace from the rail, was challenged on the final turn, dueled to the final fifty yards, was outfinished late. RUBIANOS IMAGE saved ground within easy striking range to the stretch, made a bid inside rivals in midstretch but was outfinished late. DUSTY SPIKE chased the pace racing three wide to the stretch before weakening. ASCERTAIN (IRE) settled off the early leaders while in the two path around the first turn, was never a factor.
