COWBOY MISCHIEF stalked the pace while inside, rallied three wide on the far turn making a bid then was second best in the end. DOBBINS G was allowed to settled then rallied three wide on the backstretch then made a bid but came up empty in late stretch. DAK DA MAN was allowed to settled while inside, saved ground on the far turn then made a bid and was no menace. TOAH was unhurried early then swung out to be five wide in upper stretch and was no menace. DOMINANTE duelled for the lead while two wide, was in a long dive and faltered. STARLING stalked the pace while four wide on the far turn, was used up and gave way. DANCE TO MY SONG chased the pace while three wide, was used up then stopped.
