Three-Year-Olds: 123. Older: 125 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded stakes since May 1, 2016, allowed 2 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes of \$20,000 since December 26, 2015, allowed 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. (If management considers it inadvisable for any reason to run this race on the turf course, it will be run at 6 1/2 Furlongs on the main track).

Footnotes

BETTYS BAMBINO had speed three deep between horses to press the pace then stalked outside or off the rail, came six wide into the stretch, rallied under energetic handling and some urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and won clear. STORMY LIBERAL stalked the pace inside, waited off heels entering the dirt crossing, got through to bid inside and gain the lead in upper stretch, inched away and came a bit off the rail in the drive, could not hold off the winner but saved the place. RICHARD'S BOY chased just off the rail down the hill, found room inside in the stretch and was edged for the place. HORSE LAUGH settled between horses then chased a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and was edged for the show between foes late. ACCEPTANCE dueled between horses then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. CAPE WOLFE (GB) settled outside then

chased three deep to the stretch and could not quite summon the needed late kick. OHIO (BRZ) pulled between horses and steadied twice early, angled in a bit off the rail and was in tight midway on the hill, came out four wide into the stretch and found his best stride late. HE WILL chased between rivals then angled in and saved ground down the hill and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. HOBBITS HERO sent inside to duel for the lead, fought back down the hill, was between horses into the stretch and weakened. DRUMMER (GER) a bit slow to begin, settled inside chasing the pace to the stretch and lacked a rally. HOLY LUTE stalked outside a rival then between horses on the hill, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. IRON ROB pressed the pace four wide then stalked three deep, bid again five wide into the stretch and also weakened. Rail on hill at zero.
