Footnotes

MIZZEN MAST bobbled at the start, settled off the inside, split horses with a forward move leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and rallied under urging to prove best. GIANT GENTLEMAN went up inside to stalk the early pace, bid along the rail into and on the turn and into the stretch, put a head in front past the eighth pole, could not match the winner and just held second. I LOVE SILVER lagged back off the rail without early speed, angled in on the turn and moved up inside on the bend, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and finished well. BRAINY sped to the early lead a bit off the rail, dueled outside a rival nearing and through the turn and to midstretch but weakened in the final furlong. MO MON close up stalking the pace outside on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn, weakened in the stretch. YONAGUSKA was in a good position chasing the leaders along the inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed response. DISCREET HERO chased wide on the backstretch and five wide on the turn and also could not offer the

necessary rally. EARLY FLYER well placed tracking the pace between horses then three deep into the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. UNTIL SUNDOWN chased between horses on the backstretch and four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and did not rally. GRIFFINITE bumped at the start, angled in and settled off the pace, was outside a rival leaving the turn and failed to menace. SAN NICOLAS close up outside a rival then between horses into the turn, dropped back leaving the bend and had little left. SCORPION broke in and bumped a rival, was sent between horses on the backstretch, continued outside a rival early on the turn and was not a factor. BAY HEAD KING was in a striking position wide between horses early, dropped back five wide into the turn and gave way.
