The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 123 lbs. TURF: Non-winners of a sweepstake on the turf since May 1, 2013 allowed 3 lbs.; a sweepstake on the turf in 2012-13 or four races on the turf, 5 lbs.; three races on the turf, 7 lbs. DIRT: Non-winners of a graded sweepstake on the dirt in 2012-13 allowed 3 lbs.; a sweepstake on the dirt 2012-13, 5 lbs.; four races on the dirt, 7 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered in allowances.) The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 27, 2013 with 21 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at Five and One Half Furlongs on the main track.)

SILVERETTE came away in good order, tracked the pace on the outside, engaged the leader while three wide on the turn, inched clear passing the quarter-pole, dropped to one off the rail into the stretch, extended the advantage under a strong hand ride, was put to a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker, continued under right-hand urging while clear until inside the sixteenth-pole then just held off the runner-up under a stiff hand ride to the wire. SPUN CAP was bumped on both sides at the start then in tight early, settled in the back half of the field, raced off the rail on the turn, was roused near the five-sixteenths pole, swung five wide into upper stretch, was carried out a bit near the eighth-pole, rallied outside in the final furlong and closed powerfully but missed. MADAME GIRY was well placed just off the pace on the inside, moved off the rail near the five-sixteenths then was asked, chased into upper stretch, came under a right-handed whip, drifted out near the furlong marker and weakened while able to get the show. LION DOWN BY ME bumped with SPUN CAP at the start, raced just off the pace, dropped back while two to three wide and urged along on the turn, came under the whip in the vicinity of the quarter-pole, swung six wide into upper stretch and lacked the needed response. SOUNDS OF THE CITY was in tight early, raced well back in the field, dropped further behind while inside leaving the backstretch, shifted three wide late on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and reached her best stride too late. QUEEN CHATANIKA broke a bit slow, was void of speed, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to rally. ROSA SALVAJE showed good speed, set the pace, vied a bit off the rail early on the turn then dropped to the inside, was headed at the five-sixteenths pole, dropped out at the

quarter-pole and gave way. DOUBLE THE ENERGY bumped with SPUN CAP at the start, was coaxed along while just off the pace, chased four wide on the turn and came up empty. (Rail at 18 Feet)
