FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nominations; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$1,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes on the turf allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstake or two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state bred allowance allowed 4 lbs.; of such a race allowed 6 lbs. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, April 9, 2016 with 26 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile on the Main Track.).

HIGHLAND SKY tucked along the rail and took it around the first turn, was gradually moved out into path four journeying down the backstretch, picked up interest and scurried into contention with a sustained run, got set down challenging in earnest stepping foot into the lane, came in sharply in midstretch, coming close to making some contact with TOO DISCREET, drew alongside the runner up with approximately a sixteenth remaining, fought heads apart against that stubborn rival before edging away in the final forty yards. MIGHTY MO established control in short order, cut over to the inside, set the fractions being rated along and facing only a minimal amount of pressure, had it pick up in intensity as three-quarters was being reached, went onward a little further before switched over to a drive, held out with distinction during the ensuing furlong, got looked in the eye by the winner in the general area of the sixteenth pole, vied with vigor to the end but ultimately had to settle for the second best designation. UNBRIDLED DADDY reserved in the two path to the end of the second bend, angled four wide into the stretch, got pinched after shying away from a slightly errant opponent deep into the furlong grounds, showed no ill effects from that contact and rallied for the show award. TOO DISCREET rank on the bit early, chased the pace from the two path, weakened in the final furlong. HIGHLY PRIZED (GB) raced between rivals for a good portion of the opening half while taking the two path, spun four wide into the stretch, lugged in slightly, brushed with another before flattening out. DIXIE RUNNER rated kindly in the pocket, got called upon for the stretch drive and faltered. TOUGHEST 'OMBRE travelled in the three path on each bend, commenced the stretch one path wider, was sill in midpack not making any significant headway when brushed and never regained any interest. RAPPEL raced three wide on both turns, swung six wide into the stretch and had no rally. IN EQUALITY had a ground-saving journey, was through after completing three-quarters and faded down the stretch, Following a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the stretch run in addition to a claim of foul lodged by the rider of TOUGHEST 'OMBRE against the rider of UNBRIDLED DASSY alleging interference, the result was allowed to stand and the result was declared official.
