DREAM EXTREME pressed outside, took over inside while under pressure through the final turn, dueled through the stretch, drifted out in deep stretch bumping with HURRI COIN, prevailed. HURRI COIN stalked between horses, pressed between horses through the final turn, dueled outside through the stretch, was bumped late, missed. MISS DOUBLETROUBLE saved ground, checked repeatedly through the first turn, checked again early on the final turn, dropped back, re-advanced outside, finished well. SIMPLY MARVIS steadied mildly at the break, trailed early, advanced off the rail, improved her position. UPTOWN PROSPECT stalked off the rail, inside on the final turn, finished evenly. FARM TEAM stalked wide, pressed three-wide through the final turn, was turned back. CLAIREBELL, well placed off the rail to the final turn, faded. CAT RUSH had inside speed under pressure, gave way into the final turn. The rider aboard HURRI COIN claimed foul against the rider of DREAM EXTREME for interference late in the stretch drive. DREAM EXTREME was subsequently disqualified and placed second.
