Footnotes

PIANIST quickly established control and almost as quickly tucked along the rail, cut the pace, well rated on an open lead, remained under those conditions for the initial three-quarters, entered the head of the stretch and got called upon for a response, gave it, scampered away from the others to reach the eighth pole leading by a wider margin, extended it, kept under active handling until just before the finish line. MEDOLINA assumed a forward post soon after the start, stalked the pacesetter from along the outside, within range but without applying any significant pressure, was put to encouragement by the five-sixteenths pole yet fell back slightly nonetheless, got more heavily roused once into the lane, still proved no match, but continued onward willingly to be well clear for place honors. NAYARRA (IRE) unhurried from off the inside during the initial stages, picked up interest after going more than halfway on the second turn, fanned five wide, the widest of all into the stretch, was taken hold momentarily and placed even wider shortly afterwards, the last member effected by pressure coming initially from SWEET AND LOVELY, came home well enough to be along for the show. WHOLELOTTASHAKIN darted over to the inside soon after leaving the starting gate, remained along the inside route for most of the way around the far turn, idled just off SWEET AND LOVELY's heels for a brief time under some hand urging before slipping into the two path past the five-sixteenths marker, got asked for more run angling three wide into the stretch, was taken outward and pulled off the last mentioned rival while making her way through the furlong grounds, went on to lack the needed response. SWEET AND LOVELY sat loosely pocketed for the opening six furlongs, angled outward at the quarter pole to be eventually three wide, created some but apparently enough pressure to cause three others to alter course slightly to the outside as well, had no rally. ALAURA MICHELE raced three wide around both turns, was not gaining ground when carried out slightly in upper stretch. ELUSIVE RUMOUR four wide down the elbow chute, stayed parked out at least three wide until late on the far turn, folded.
