FOR TWO-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$1,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight, 122 lbs.

Non-winners of a race other than claiming allowed 2 lbs.; maidens, 4 lbs. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. Closed Saturday October 17, 2015 with 30 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile on the main track.)

Footnotes

MOUNTAIN MUSIC MAN a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, tracked the pace inside behind the cover of the leader DON'T BE SALTY to the half mile pole, came under coaxing inside three furlongs out with clearance along the hedge, angled five wide into upper stretch, rallied into contention a furlong out, dug in under a drive taking over a sixteenth out, then inched away to the finish. CONVERGE four wide near the rear, came under encouragement five-sixteenths from home, angled seven wide into upper stretch, offered up a good finish to close in belatedly for the place honors. PAGAN in reserve just off the inside near the rear, tucked to the hedge half a mile from home, came under urging nearing the five-sixteenths, angled four to five wide into upper stretch, kept on for the show honors. RAPPEL forwardly placed just off the inside in hand between foes, came under coaxing midway on the far turn three wide, seized command nearing the quarter pole and swung three wide at the top of the stretch, dug in under threat from the eventual winner clinging to the front a furlong out, got headed near the sixteenth marker and weakened late on. STRIKE MIDNIGHT just off the pace three to four wide, came under

coaxing three furlongs from home, angled six to seven wide into upper stretch and weakened in the drive. HEATED VERDICT three wide in pursuit from mid pack, got set down spinning just off the inside for home, offered no response. DON'T BE SO SALTY in hand on the pace along the inside, came under coaxing from the two path midway on the far turn, got headed nearing the quarter pole, spun just off the hedge into the stretch and tired. HOTINTHEHAMPTONS broke out at the start bumping and leaning on EIDMILAAD, attended the pace four then three wide, tucked to the two path half a mile from home in behind the top pair, came under a ride three furlongs from home, swung four wide at the quarter pole and faltered. IMPERIAL WARRIOR five wide in the clear near the rear, came under urging three furlongs out and tucked to the three path with five-sixteenths to go, continued three wide into upper stretch, made no impact. EIDMILAAD bumped and leaned on at the start by HOTINTHEHAMPTONS, who broke outwards, raced four then three wide in reserve in mid pack, came under a ride three furlongs out, swung four wide at the head of the stretch and gave way. MONSTER BEA fell to his face at the start and lost the rider. There was a Stewards' Inquiry into the start focusing on MONSTER BEA before the result was declared official.
