 FOR COLTS AND GELDINGS, TWO YEARS OLD WHICH ARE REGISTERED MINNESOTA BREDS. By subscription of a \$500 nomination on or before November 1, 2004. A late payment of \$2,500 will be accepted on or before May 1, 2005. \$250 to pass the entry box and \$250 additional to start. With \$55,000 estimated (\$17,000 from Canterbury Park and \$22,000 from the Minnesota Breeders' Fund with the balance to include nominations from the MTA, entry and starting fees), of which 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. WEIGHT: 120 lbs. Maidens allowed 3 lbs. WINNERS PREFERRED. (Non-starters least preferred). Total earnings will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to 12 horses. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. Starters to be named through the entry box by the closing time of entries. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner by the Minnesota Thoroughbred Association (MTA). Nominations closed with 75. (S)

Footnotes

THE K B KID broke readily, attended a rival's pace under light rating racing to the turn, forged clear nearing midstretch, then widened his advantage while drifting out under pressure. EDDIE RASCAL was angled inside tracking just off the first flight racing to the bend, came out three deep to challenge nearing upper stretch, angled inwards under pressure racing through the stretch and proved best of the others while never gaining terms with the winner. AUDIAHVO, bumped, then forced inwards a bit after the start, tracked the leaders along the inside to the turn, swung out nearing upper stretch and made some late progress to improve position. BOW RIVER broke sharply, settled into a tracking position outside foes, was hustled along five wide nearing the turn to gain striking position but offered no final bid. C C TAT drifted inwards after the start, bumped AUDIAHVO, angled inside to track the leaders to upper stretch but offered no closing bid. TRACKER BERT was sent to the lead inside foes, dueled for command into the lane and gave way. RED ROLLER vied four wide between foes from the break, was shuffled back in traffic nearing the turn and soon gave way. RAJENDRA was never a factor. BJELLEBO flashed brief pace three wide between foes in the opening quarter but dropped out early.
