### Footnotes

SAUDI POETRY hopped a bit at the start and bobbed soon after, moved up in good order to press front-running ASHER three or four wide, took over from that one just before going six furlongs, then held off ROYAL FAIR under strong handling. ROYAL FAIR settled inside early, went along under light rating, saved ground until the stretch, swung out seven wide for the drive, drifted out at the sixteenth pole when sharply roused left-handed, then, after the rider switched the stick back to the right side, was getting to the winner at the end. DREAMS GALLORE, reserved early and four or five wide most of the way, made an earnest bid on the second turn approaching the stretch, loomed prominently for the last eighth but couldn't make up the difference. BORDELAISE (ARG), a bit sluggish to begin, saved ground, commenced a bid from between rivals near the inside approaching the stretch, raced within easy striking distance into the final furlong but lacked a late response. ASHER gained the lead at the start, edged inward, went along under careful handling while controlling the pace through moderate fractions, showed the way for nearly six furlongs and gave way grudgingly thereafter. SECRET STATUS saved ground from the start while within easy striking distance, was lightly checked on the first turn, continued in contention throughout but failed to rally. MARCH MAGIC, well placed from the outset while tracking the leaders four or five wide, moved between foes on the second turn but flattened out when straightened for the drive. SPARKLES OF LUCK went up early to press ASHER from the outside, continued forwardly to the end of the backstretch, tired and wasn't persevered with in the drive.
