**Footnotes**

MOCHA QUEEN, outrun early, raced in behind horses, split foes four wide in the final furlong, came out and bumped with NICOLE'S DREAM at the sixteenth pole and was hard ridden the remainder. BLACK ESCORT, outrun to the lane while in behind horses, eased out between rivals six wide for the drive and was second best. DYNA DA WYNA contested the pace inside early, angled out five wide leaving the turn, loomed prominently but couldn't muster the needed response. NICOLE'S DREAM angled in early to force the pace, took over, edged clear, made the pace into deep stretch, then, when weakening, was bumped by the winner when MOCHA QUEEN advanced from the inside. KISS ME KATIE, five or six wide around the turn, came wider into the lane and lacked a rally. FEATHER MARAINE, within striking distance inside to the stretch, maneuvered out six wide for the drive but failed to rally. GLITTERBDANCING wasn't a threat. MS. TRICK OR TREAT, within striking distance to the stretch while four or five wide, weakened thereafter. FLOAT AND STING was outrun. G MANS GAL raced forwardly inside to the lane and weakened. SILVER WENCH raced forwardly between foes contesting the pace early, continued within striking distance four or five wide to the stretch and faltered.
