FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. Free nominations. \$200 to enter. Nominations close Wednesday, September 8, 2010. Purse will be \$75,000. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing 7th thru last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to sixth. Supplemental nominations may be made at the time of entry Wednesday, September 15, 2010 by payment of \$5,000 each (includes all fees). Weights: Three Year Olds, 120 lbs.; Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes in 2010 allowed 3 lbs., non-winners of \$22,000 since July 1, allowed 5 lbs, non-winners of a race other than maiden or claiming since June 1, allowed 7 lbs. Field will be limited toten starters with four alternates. Preference to stakes winners in order (Grade I, Grade II, Grade III), then stakes winners, then highest earnings in 2010. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Trophy to the owner off the winner.

MISS DOLCE broke sharp from between foes to gain a clear early margin, remained well clear up the backstretch, held a clear advantage entering the drive, was clear at the eighth pole, responded when challenged mid stretch, drifted in bothering MISS RED DELICIOUS deep stretch and was clear late. After a Stewards' Inquiry and Jockey's objection MISS DOLCE was disqualified for interference in the stretch. MISS RED DELICIOUS stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, made a bid entering the drive, was steadied when MISS DOLCE drifted in deep stretch, recovered and finished gamely. DOUBLE ESPRESSO chased the early pace from the outside, remained forward entering the second turn but could not match strides. SHEFOGGEDMYGLASSES outrun early, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded and was gaining late. CHERRYBLOSSOMMISS pressed the early pace outside but had nothing left for the drive. BLUE DIAMOND ALLIE went evenly. CHELSEA BARTON had a steady fade. HUGE was never close. BEST REWARD was finished early.
