Footnotes

SYNCLINE was checked and steadied along behind the leaders and inside rivals for more than six furlongs, found room along the rail out of the second turn then narrowly outfinished several rivals late in a stiff drive. DR. KASHNIKOW made a three wide middle move to contention after five furlongs, loomed boldly in the middle of the course in the furlong grounds then drifted in slightly in the late stages while just missing. SARDAUKAR (GB) made a middle move after six furlongs, fanned five wide for the drive, also loomed a threat in the furlong grounds before being outfinished late. DOG TAGS was also boxed and steadied along for six furlongs, found some room between rivals in the furlong grounds then checked up nearing the finish. MARQUETTE set a slow pace to mid stretch then also steadied while tiring. MUS-IF (GB) turned in a dull effort. JOHNNY DOLLAR stopped. A claim of foul by the trainer of DOG TAGS against the winner for interference in deep stretch was disallowed. The portable inner rail was set out 15 feet.
