PRENUPTIAL settled off the rail then angled in, moved up inside on the turn, came out in the stretch, bid between foes in deep stretch and gamely prevailed under left handed urging. SWISS ROSE stalked the pace inside, came out on the turn, split rivals three deep into the stretch, also bid between foes past midstretch and continued willingly to the wire. SHAROANA had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away leaving the turn, fought back along the inside in the final furlong and also went on gamely to the end. CES'T MARK chased outside, went four wide on the turn and into the stretch, bid outside foes in deep stretch and was outfinished. WON MORE PENNY was in a good position stalking the pace three deep on the backstretch and turn, lacked the needed response. LITTLE CITY dueled outside a rival on the backstretch and most of the turn, stalked off the rail leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch. HIGH CHOLESTEROL chased between horses on the backstretch and into the turn, dropped back leaving the turn and gave way.
