Breeders' Cup monies also correspondingly divided, provided a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Footnotes

EL CORREDOR came out on the first turn and stalked outside a rival, bid three deep on the backstretch and second turn, took a short lead in upper stretch, responded when headed late and gamely prevailed between horses. FIGLIO MIO chased outside, moved up outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, bid three deep past midstretch and continued gamely to the wire. PERFORMING MAGIC saved ground just off the pace, moved up inside leaving the second turn, bid inside in the stretch, put a head in front in deep stretch and also went willingly to the end. SMILE AGAIN sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, duelled inside rivals leaving the backstretch and on the second turn and between horses nearing the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. BUDROYALE was in a good position stalking the early pace off the rail, bid between horses on the backstretch and to the middle of the second turn, then dropped back and also weakened. BRIGHT VALOUR settled off the rail, went between horses on the backstretch, fell back and angled in on the second turn and gave way.
