KENTUCKY STORM was not asked for speed to the second turn, went outside to commence her bid at the three eighths, was fanned five wide into the lane, responded with a game rally to collar MISS PIXIE in the deep stretch and held off MARY KIES under mostly aggressive hand urging. MARY KIES took back at the start to lag well behind the field while dropping to the inside, began her bid once on the final turn, split foes nearing the quarter pole to reach serious contention then closed with good speed to the final stages but could not get by the winner. MISS PIXIE set the pace from the outset, drew clear on the second turn, extended her advantage in the upper stretch but faded in the closing stages. GUTHRUN (FR) saved ground early while rated off the pace, came three wide to the stretch but lacked a closing response. LATTER DAY PAULA stalked the pace four wide to the second turn, checked from between horses near the quarter pole but had little left for the drive. PURE IN EXCESS stalked the pace two wide to the second turn and gave way after dropping inside. MIMI'S TIZZY tracked the pace three wide to the second turn, shifted inside at mid turn but had nothing left. BLONDE BOUNTY was never a factor and was eased in the stretch but walked off.
