HIGHWAY BOSS away well and tracked the leaders through the stretch the first time while racing one out from the rail, maintained his position in the run down the backstretch, commenced his bid three wide entering the final turn and quickly assumed command, and drew clear in the stretch drive while being ridden out late. CRAZY PROPHET broke sharply and was allowed to settle off the early pace while racing three wide through the stretch the first time, raced six wide in the run down the backstretch, rallied four out from the rail entering the final turn, and closed willingly five wide in the drive to get up for the place. NEVERADOUBT settled off the early pace while racing one out from the rail through the stretch the first time, advanced two wide midway down the backstretch, rallied three wide through the final turn, and closed willingly three wide in the drive to be along for a share. SHOOTING JACKET settled off the early pace while saving ground at the rail in the run through the stretch the first time, commenced his bid three out from the rail entering the final turn, and closed willingly four wide in the drive to finish on even terms with MODERN. MODERN away alertly and pressed the pace two wide entering the stretch the first time, eased off the leader through the stretch to hold a tracking trip through the second turn, re-engaged the in the run down the backstretch, rallied two

wide entering the final turn, had no response when tackled by HIGHWAY BOSS soon after entering the turn, but battled gamely two wide in the drive to finish on even terms with SHOOTING JACKET. VENETIAN MASK stalked the leaders three wide entering the stretch the first time, rallied two out from the rail entering the final turn, and finished two out from the rail in the stretch drive. DON'T HOLD ME BACK settled off the early pace while racing one out from the rail through the stretch the first time, commenced his bid two wide entering the final turn, and finished evenly two wide in the drive. SOL CAT settled off the early pace while racing three wide entering the stretch the first time, rallied five wide entering the final turn, but failed to make a late impact. MOON KING raced to the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, set a pressured pace from along the rail in the run down the backstretch and into the final turn, but faded in the late stages. CALGARY CAPER unhurried early while dropping back to trail, was always well back and failed to make a late impact. LORD VANCOUVER settled off the early pace while racing two wide through the stretch the first time, raced mid pack into the backstretch, but lacked the needed closing response when called upon.
