Three year olds, 123 lbs.; Older, 126 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Shadwell Keeneland Turf Mile will be limited to ten. In the event that more than ten horses pass the entry box, the ten starters will be determined at that time with preference to nominees that have won a graded or group turf stakes; next, graded stakes winners, then highest turf earnings in 1999. **Footnotes**

KIRKWALL (GB), well placed from the start while stalking the leaders three or four wide, was between foes while reaching the front approaching the final quarter, edged clear between calls while drifting out, then was fully extended while continuing to drift while holding DELAY OF GAME safe. The latter, never far back, followed the winner from the outside five or six wide into the stretch, loomed boldly through the drive while outside KIRKWALL (GB) and hung. LADIES DIN, outrun early and unhurried, was forced out in tight quarters while advancing between rivals entering the second turn, bobbed badly and nearly unseated the rider, recovered, rallied six wide from between rivals into the stretch, reached contention for the final furlong but lacked a further response. GARBU, well placed inside early, fell back inside on the backstretch, was forced out early on the second turn, bumped with JOE WHO (BRZ), circled foes 10 wide when straightened for the drive and improved position. TAKARIAN (IRE), bumped at the start, was never far back, moved up on the backstretch to force the pace three or four wide, continued prominent to the stretch and weakened. KAHAL (GB), unhurried for a half made a sweeping run five or six wide on the second turn, gained near even terms for the lead nearing the stretch but flattened out soon after. QUIET RESOLVE, forwardly placed inside early, fell back on the backstretch, came out to avoid a tiring RAY'S APPROVAL tightening it up on LADIES DIN forcing that one out, then lacked a further account. ROB 'N GIN leaned in at the start bumping TAKARIAN (IRE), stalked the leaders three or four wide, gained a narrow advantage nearing the end of the backstretch, held on well until approaching the stretch and tired. RAY'S APPROVAL moved clear early, made the pace for a half, tired, bobbed early on the second turn and was finished. JOE WHO (BRZ), outrun from early on, was bumped by GARBU when that one was forced out early on the second turn, appeared to clip the heels of that one and fell.
