STAKES Princess S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR TWO YEAR OLD FILLIES. Weight: 122 lbs. Non winners of a Sweepstakes allowed 2 lbs.; \$10,000 twice allowed 4 lbs.; \$12,000 once allowed 6 lbs. Maidens allowed 8 lbs. No Nomination Fee. \$200 to pass the entry box on Wednesday, July 11 and an additional \$300 to start on Saturday, July 14 with \$50,000 (less payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through ninth - with any unpaid monies reverting to the purse account) Guaranteed of which the remaining 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth and 2% to fifth. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Should this race not be divided and the entry number exceeds the starting gate capacity, high weights will be preferred. Different owners will have equal draw according to weights. The second part of same owner entries will have no consideration over a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. The Owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Nominations closed Friday, July 6, 2007 with 25 nominees. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at Five Furlongs) (Rail at 10 feet).

SHEDOESROCK broke out, raced off the early pace, came four wide when roused out of the turn, finished well to be in time. AMERICAN PRIZE closest to the leader while outside that one, could not match the winner in the late going, up in the final strides for the place. TOP STORY sprinted clear soon after the start, continued to hold a daylight advantage in the turn, failed to respond to the winner's challenge late and was nipped in the final stages for the place. GONE DIXIE evenly paced, came five wide into the stretch, failed to muster much of a rally. BROKEN MYSTERY off a bit slow, was never a serious threat. HUMBLE ANNE was never involved. MY GIRL BESS forwardly placed early along the inside, staged a steady retreat after three furlongs.
