INUIT FISHER stalked the pace on the rail, bid at the quarter pole and assumed command in the upper stretch. HOWSITGOINGHOTSHOT raced evenly from three wide, rallied in the upper stretch, ran evenly in the stretch and held place. HURRICANE TIKI raced evenly to the outside, rallied three wide in the upper stretch and finished well to close on place. LAKETON entered the first turn four wide first turn, raced evenly while close up and made a mild rally from three wide. SUMMER SENSATION broke sharply, set the pace on the rail but weakened in the second turn and dropped back in the stretch. ECTON'S GEM saved ground raced evenly. IDIDN'TDOANYTHING lacked speed, trailed and rallied for a late gain.
