MEADOWOOD bore in leaving the starting gate, hugged the rail in a forward position, was taken to the two path approaching the eighth pole, took the lead outside BREWING approaching the sixteenth pole then drew off under urging. BREWING, clear early, was angled in leaving the backstretch, set the pace along the rail and weakened late. PRUDHOE BAY chased the pace two wide around the turn, was in contention entering the stretch and weakened the final furlong. GERMANIAC, lightly brushed by EXTRASEXYHIPZSTER when that one was forced in leaving the starting gate, was checked in close quarters entering the turn, saved ground on the turn, turned for home in the two path and failed to rally. JESSETHEMARINE, steadied when forced in and placed in tight quarters by the winner soon after the break, advanced three deep outside horses leaving the turn then tired in upper stretch. MOON SONG, between horses on the turn, was three wide entering the stretch then retreated. EXTRASEXYHIPZSTER, steadied in tight quarters soon after the break, steadied on a rival's heels leaving the backstretch, circled the turn four deep and was outrun.
