MALIBU PIER had good early speed and dueled inside, stalked a bit off the rail on the second turn, re-bid alongside LILLY FA POOTZ into the stretch, battled on a short lead three deep in midstretch and inched away late under urging. TURNING TOP (IRE) chased a bit off the rail, moved up some on the second turn then bobbled when losing her footing midway on that turn, came out three deep into the stretch and finished with interest. LILLY FA POOTZ pulled her way along outside then dueled alongside a rival, inched clear into the second turn, fought back into the stretch and between horses in the drive and held third. WASHINGTON BRIDGE stalked the pace inside, cut the corner into the stretch, bid inside in the drive and was outfinished. ECLAIR DE LUNE (GER) broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail, steadied when coming out behind foes on the second turn, swung out into the stretch and split horses at the wire. IT TIZ chased outside a rival, steadied in tight off heels midway on the second turn, came out four wide into the stretch and was outfinished.
