Footnotes

KAHAL (GB) was void of early speed along the rail, saved ground through the turn, roused between horses in upper stretch, came four wide with less than a furlong to go and was full of run beating GONE FISHIN to the wire. The latter raced as a pair with KAHAL (GB) in the early going, swung wide in upper stretch and closed willingly well off the rail, but was passed by the winner in the final strides. MR. EPPERSON forced the early pace three wide, assumed command in upper stretch, but could not hold off the late chargers and gave way in the late going. APALACHIAN CHIEF was void of early speed just off the rail, angled out in upper stretch, but was shut off in mid stretch, moved wider still in the final sixteenth and finished well. RUN LIL TOOCH was hustled along pressing the early pace between horses then weakened in the stretch. CRUCIBLE was in hand between horses, but lacked a late response and ran evenly. PROWL (AUS) showed good early speed and set a pressured pace then gave way in the turn and dropped back. GORDY'S OUR MAN was allowed to settle in the middle of the pack outside of rivals, made a mild bid in upper stretch, but flattened out in the final furlong. CLEVER RESPONSE was void of early speed inside of rivals, but never rallied and was never a factor. BOLD FACT was in hand inside of rivals, angled out in upper stretch but failed to respond and dropped back.
