FOR TWO-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$250 each to accompany the nomination and an additional \$2,500 to enter; with \$175,000 guaranteed and an additional \$75,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup nominees only. (No Canadian Bred Allowance) This field will be limited to 14 entries. Final entries to be made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. Closed September 19, 2007 with 19 nominations.

Footnotes

GLOBETROTTER broke in the air then raced off the pace, angled out closing on the far turn, bid a furlong out then prevailed in a furlong long battle with COOL GATOR. COOL GATOR, always in range, was hard ridden from two-wide to four-wide on the far turn, bid at the 1/8 pole, dueled to the wire but was outfinished. SAADA steadied a bit at the start, stalked four-wide then three-wide on the first turn, was hustled two-wide through the far turn and finished gamely while no match for the top two. MIGHTY VOW broke outward bothering Saada, pressed the pace, chased two-wide on the far turn then lacked a clear path midstretch, altered course a bit but evened out. STORM CODE led quickly, set a reserved pace, quickened on the turn but yielded with a furlong to run and tired. TURF WAR pressed from the inside, gave way on the far turn and lacked a closing response.
