FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. Nominations close on Saturday June 19, 2004 with no fee. \$125 to pass the entry box and additional \$125 to start, with \$40,000 added of which 60% of all monies to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$40,000 once at one mile or over in 2004, allowed 2 lbs.; \$30,000 once at any distance since December 1, 2003, allowed 4 lbs.; \$24,000 once at any distance since November 1, 2003, allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in estimating allowances) The field will be limited to twelve (12) starters; Highweights on the scale preferred. Total earnings in 2004 will be used to determine the order of preference of horses assigned equal weight(on the scale). Closed Saturday, June 19, 2004 with 19 nominations.

KORBYN GOLD was void of speed and was never a factor. MARLEY'S REVENGE raced close up and tired. CANADIAN RIVER set a pressured pace from the inside and tired.
