PUBLICATION raced close up between horses, responded to take a short lead in the stretch and gamely turned back the late challenge of IT'SALLINTHECHASE. IT'SALLINTHECHASE was void of early speed while just outside, came farther out in the stretch for the drive and challenged late but could not get past the winner. DUBAI SQUIRE raced prominently three wide, challenged in the stretch and loomed a threat but lacked the necessary winning move. MAJOR STORM saved ground near the middle of the field, challenged from the rail in the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. TINKER raced well off the rail near the middle of the field, came five wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. NO TROUBLE never reached a contending position. LUNAR BOUNTY moved up to take a short lead leaving the chute, set all of the pace from the rail while pressed and tired in the drive.
