GO AGAIN VALID outrun early, came wide for the drive, finished gamely from the outside and was up in the final strides. JENA JENA bumped at the start, contested the pace from the outside and fought it out gamely to the finish. TROPICAL PUNCH steadied at the start, contested the pace and dug in gamely through the stretch. RILLS broke sluggishly but flashed good speed along the inside, was steadied inside on the turn, dropped back and finished well on the rail. COMMON OBJECTIVE bumped at the start, chased the pace while three wide and lacked a closing kick. CASANOVA MARKET bumped at the start and outrun early, raced inside and lacked a rally. T STORM bumped at the start, drifted on the turn and tired. BAG LADY JANE ducked in at the start, raced inside and tired in the stretch.
