Footnotes

ZIVO saved ground for six furlongs, was taken outward and given his cue, came five wide into the stretch, gained ground rapidly in the last eighth and collared SARATOGA SNACKS in the last few jumps to earn the decision. SARATOGA SNACKS sat patiently perched three wide on each bend, moved up to issue a challenge for command during the later stages of the run around the far turn, got put to a drive shortly after COMANDANTE did, took over, dug in with good determination to the end, but got caught near the wire nonetheless. AWESOME VISION unhurried while two wide for nearly three-quarters, swung one path wider into the stretch, finished willingly en route for the show. MONEYINYOUR POCKET slipped out of the pocket coming to the midway point on the far turn, was asked for some run a sixteenth later, failed to pick up the pace. THIS HARD LAND three wide on both turns, was put to a drive by the three-eighths pole, folded. COMANDANTE swerved in slightly as the gate sprung open, making some contact with left side of it, assumed a forward position, pressed the issue from the two path, took over leaving the backstretch with the runner up in tow to his outside, got asked when challenged by that opponent nearing the quarter pole, being the first of the two to have its pilot commit to some encouragement, surrendered the lead before completing the next furlong and gave way. MODERN CHILD broke on top and maintained the advantage as the field made its way down the homestretch, showed the way from the inside, facing some pressure from another pair perched to his outside, yielded to each shortly upon departing the backstretch and faltered.
