HEAD HEART HOOF away well, attended the pace from the two path well rated, got roused nearing the quarter pole and took command at that station, edged clear to the eighth pole under a drive, saw that margin cut into in the late stages, dug in to hold on and prevail. JOHANNESBURG SMILE tracked the pace inside from close range, came under coaxing just past the three-eighths pole, cut the corner into the stretch, angled out around a weakening foe nearing the eighth pole, then shifted back inside near the sixteenth marker while offering up a good kick to surge late and just miss. SINAI three wide in pursuit from close range, got set down at the five-sixteenths, offered up a mild kick through the stretch which proved not enough to answer the top pair while garnering the show honors. P J'S MAGICAL WINK broke out at the start and was corrected, set the pace along the inside attended from the outside, got let out when displaced at the quarter pole, kept on inside until the final furlong before weakening in the late stages. ISN'T HE PERFECT three to four wide towards the rear of a compact group, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home and offered no serious response. MINE OVER MATTER leapt at the start conceding four or five lengths to the front, made a four to five wide bid under light coaxing through the turn into contention nearing the five-sixteenths, cornered four wide in upper stretch and steadily weakened thereafter.
