WINDRUSH raced close up outside while in hand, advanced three wide on the second turn, responded when roused in upper stretch, dug in gamely under steady left handed whipping and bested TURNOFTHECENTURY after a long drive. TURNOFTHECENTURY quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace along the inside while in hand, responded when joined from the outside by the winner turning for home and fought it out gamely along the rail. BOSTON PARTY was bumped at the start, was rated inside, rallied three wide approaching the stretch and stayed on well to the finish. K. O.'S CRYPTO was bumped at the start and unhurried along the inside early, came wide into the stretch and lacked a solid closing kick. TIBADO chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. BANNER HEADLINE was steadied after the start, was outrun early, put in a three wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch. TALK'S CHEAP chased the pace while between rivals and tired. LE BEAUCET dropped back after the start, raced inside and had no rally.
