Footnotes

MIGHTY MORRIS set the pace under pressure along the rail, surrendered the lead momentarily at the three-eighths pole, fought back to gain a slim advantage on the turn, battled heads apart along the rail into deep stretch and prevailed after a long drive. MANTECA pressed the pace in the two path on the backstretch, lodged a move from outside to put a head in front at the three-eighths pole, fought outside the winner leaving the quarter pole and yielded grudgingly. NAUGHTY NEW YORKER was outrun early after a slow start, raced under a firm hold on the first turn, moved out entering the backstretch, made a strong four wide middle move nearing the far turn, fought three wide into upper stretch and held well to gain a share. ICABAD CRANE raced well in hand between horses along the backstretch, closed the gap three wide to reach contention on the turn and flattened out. RUFFINO raced well in hand along the rail, angled three wide while gaining near the quarter pole and lacked a strong closing response. DR. D. F. C. was outrun after breaking slowly, trailed for six furlongs, circled five wide to catch the field on the turn and flattened out. POCKET COWBOYS pressed three wide for five furlongs and gave way on the turn.
