COUNTRY HIDEAWAY was unhurried along the inside on the backstretch, angled out and rallied four wide approaching the stretch, reached the front in upper stretch then dug in gamely and prevailed under a drive. CRITICAL EYE argued the pace while three wide and stayed on gamely to the finish. JOSTLE stumbled after the start, was unhurried early, rallied five wide nearing the stretch and finished gamely outside. FOLLY DOLLAR was hustled to the front, set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. POIVRE (CHI) chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. DAT YOU MIZ BLUE turned her head at the start and was away behind the field then raced with the pace while in hand between rivals and tired after three quarters. DON'T PINCH ME chased the pace while between rivals and tired.
